DEFINITION OF DIVISIONS ETC. (other information & entry form on reverse side)

BEGINNER - Beginner riders of any age. **May not enter in any other under saddle classes.** Handlers are always permitted in all Beginner Division Classes. **May only enter the following classes (according to age): 201-203/206/207/208/219-222/232 (may not enter Small Fry classes)**

CROSSRAILS - Open to horses OR riders beginning over fences. Either **beginner rider** must show O/F in crossrails **only** OR **beginner horse** must show over fences in crossrails **only**. May trot or canter courses. Crossrails will be available for warm-up in the regular warm-up arena during classes 101 through 109.

DISCIPLINE ON RAIL - An advanced/on demand class called by judge with no preset pattern - any movement in english pleasure or dressage may be used. A minimum of one lateral movement, one extension or collection, and one change of direction. Does not count towards end of day high point.

GAITED/RACKING - Open to Gaited horses of any type or breed

GREEN HORSE - Open to horses in **FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING U/S IN RESPECTIVE DISCIPLINE. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

LTD - LTD. is limited to riders who have NEVER cantered in a horse show in their respective discipline. Handlers permitted during line-up. **May only enter the following classes (according to age): 110-113/114-117/118-121/122-125/201-203/219-222/223/228/232**

RUSTY STIRRUP - Open to beginner adult walk trot riders or adult riders no longer comfortable showing at the canter. This class is NOT an open adult walk-trot class. **May only enter the following classes (meeting other class qualif.): 112/113/126/201-203/209-212/222/224/229/232**

SADDLE SEAT - requires appropriate tack and attire and will require the horse to be able to perform 3 gaits: walk, trot or rack, and canter.

SHOWMANSHIP - will run in arena B concurrent with other classes during designated hours. Pattern only. **Horse may be shown in saddles.**

SMALL FRY - Pre-Beginner riders of any age. **May not enter in any other under saddle classes.** Handlers are always permitted in all Beginner Division Classes. **May only enter the following classes (according to age): 201-205/219-222/232 (may not enter Beginner classes)**

PATTERN & TRAIL - will run in arena B concurrent with other classes during designated hours. LTD and Rusty Spur riders must ride in LTD or RS designated classes. **In-Hand Trail** course to be completed with horse shown from the ground (in-hand). **Horse may show in saddles.**

ALL CLASSES GOVERNED BY NCSC RULES

ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

ATTIRE - Proper attire required in all classes-Judge may excuse jackets.
CHAMPIONSHIP - To be eligible, horse must have been entered and judged in a qualifying class in that division (pleasure and/or equitation)
COGGINS - Original/Certified Copy of Current Negative Coggins required for horse to be allowed to remain on the grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
DAY HIGH POINT - High Point and Reserve High Point ribbons awarded in: 2'-2'3 Hunter, 2'6-2'9 Hunter, Beginning Crossrails 11 & Under, Beginning Crossrails 12-18, Small Fry, Beginner, Gaited, Saddle Seat, LTD 9 & Under, LTD 10-13, LTD 14-18, Rusty Stirrup, 13 & Under, 14-18, and Adult.
Hunter Hack to count towards both O/F divisions.
ENTRIES - Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes.
GROUNDS FEE - \$20/horse - must pay either grounds or stall fee.
HEAD GEAR - All riders in Over Fences Classes must wear protective head gear. Any exhibitor may wear protective head gear without penalty from the judge. Helmets must be worn in jumping warmup arenas at all times.
PAYBACK (\$\$) - There must be 5 entries in the class in order to receive payback. Payback 1st 30%, 2nd 20%, and 3rd 10% based on \$5.
PAYMENT - Open Check or payment in full at sign up. If check is not closed out at end of day what we show on our computer will be deemed

correct and check will be filled in accordingly. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
PRE-ENTRY - Must be received by 10:00 pm the Tuesday prior to the show. **On-Line:** www.newtoncountysaddleclub.com **Fax/Phone:** 770-385-7383 or **Email:** ncscpreentry@yahoo.com. This is the **ONLY** way you may reserve a stall. **There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to the pre-entry deadline. Form must be filled out COMPLETELY.** Reserve RV's her also.
RAIN - SHOW WILL BE CONDUCTED RAIN OR SHINE
RV SITES - \$25 per night. Thursday drop off - no hookup/no charge.
SCRATCH/ADD CLASSES - Scratches and add/ons of classes must be accomplished **2 classes prior** to the class that is scratched or added enters the arena. This must be done by completing a scratch/add slip at the show office. You will be charged for classes scratched without following this procedure.
STALLS - Stalls may be reserved by pre-entry **ONLY**. Sat night stalls must move in AFTER 12pm on Saturday. No more than two stalls per entry. **Requests for stall location will be honored first come/first served. To be stalled together, please help us by pre-entering together.**
SHAVINGS - GIHP requires a minimum of 2 bags of shavings per stall. Order and pay by credit card through **Queen Shavings** at 770-860-9111 or 678-416-1424 or at the show grounds at Queen Shavings Building.
