DEFINITION OF DIVISIONS (other information & entry form on reverse side)

ADVANCED BEGINNER - Beginner riders of any age. **May not enter in any other under saddle classes.** Handlers are allowed but must stay at least 15' from horse. **May also enter Halter, Showmanship, Beginner/Challenged Rider Trail and In-Hand Trail. May not enter Leadline or Beginner classes.**

BAREBACK HORSEMANSHIP - Horsemanship pattern to be shown bareback. **Does not count toward end of day high point.**

BEGINNER - Beginner riders of any age. **May not enter in any other under saddle classes.** Handlers are **required** to lead or walk next to the horse's head. **May also enter Halter, Showmanship, Beginner/Challenged Rider Trail and In-Hand Trail. May not enter Leadline or Adv. Beginner classes.**

CHALLENGED RIDER - Special needs riders of any age. **May also enter Halter, Beginner/Challenged Rider Trail, and In-Hand Trail.**

DISCIPLINE ON RAIL - An advanced/on demand class called by judge with no preset pattern - any movement in western pleasure or reining may be used. A minimum of one lateral movement, one extension or collection and one change of direction. **Does not count towards end of day high point.**

GREEN HORSE - Open to horses in first year of showing u/s in respective discipline. **Does not count toward end of day high point.**

HALTER - Open to horses of specified sex and age categories. Performance Horse Halter - horse **must enter and show** in a performance class at the show. Color halter is open to horses, registered or not, where the color is governed by a registry.

JR HORSE LUNGE LINE - Open to Jr.horses of all disciplines (5 & under) **not being shown under saddle. Does not count toward end of day high point.**

LTD - LTD. is limited to riders who have NEVER cantered in a horse show in their respective discipline (except one at a time). Handlers permitted during line-up. **May also enter Crossrails, Halter, Showmanship and In-Hand Trail. May not canter at other shows while in this division.**

MASTERS - Adult walk jog riders 45 years of age and over. **May not show in canter classes in NCSC shows. May also enter Halter, Open WJ, Green Horse WJ (on a green horse), Showmanship, and In-Hand Trail.**

PETITE - Horse/Donkey 48" or under. Classes judged by AMHR guidelines (except where superceded by NCSC rules). **No youth with Stallions. Youth Driving:** headers required - adult allowed to ride along in cart.

RUSTY SPUR - Open to adult walk jog riders 19through 44 years of age. **May not show in canter classes in NCSC shows. May also enter Halter, Open WJ, Green Horse WJ (on a green horse), Showmanship, and In-Hand Trail.**

SHOWMANSHIP - will run in arena B concurrent with other classes during designated hours. Pattern only. **Horses may show with saddle on.**

TRAIL - will run in arena B concurrent with other classes. **Beginner/Challenged Rider Trail** - to be accompanied by handler (on line, attending horse's head or in arena).

In-Hand Trail to be completed with horse shown from the ground. **Horses may show in saddle and halter.**

**ALL CLASSES GOVERNED BY NCSC RULES (PETITE - AMHR GUIDELINES except where superceded by NCSC rules)
ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**

ATTIRE - Proper attire required in all classes-Judge may excuse jackets.

CHAMPIONSHIP - To be eligible, horse must have been entered and judged in a qualifying class in that div. (pleasure and/or eq.) Must have 2 entries to hold class.

COGGINS - Original/Certified Copy of Current Negative Coggins required for horse to be allowed to remain on the grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

DAY HIGH POINT - High Point and Reserve High Point ribbons awarded in: Halter, LTD 11 & Under, LTD 12-18, Rusty Spur, Masters, 13 & Under, 14-18, 19 & Over, Petite Adult & Youth, Challenged Rider, Beginner, Advanced Beginner. There must be at least 2 riders in a division for day end high point to be awarded. Points in any Championship class will be doubled - ties will be awarded.

ENTRIES - Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes.

GROUND FEE - \$22/horse - **each horse must pay either grounds or stall fee.**

HEAD GEAR - Any exhibitor may wear protective head gear without penalty from the judge.

PAYBACK (\$\$) - There must be 5 entries in the class in order to receive payback. Payback 1st 30%, 2nd 20%, and 3rd 10% based on \$5.

PAYMENT - Open Check or payment in full at sign up. If check is not closed out at end of day what we show on our computer will be deemed correct.

PRE-ENTRY - Must be received by 10:00 pm the Tuesday prior to the show.

RAIN - SHOW WILL BE CONDUCTED RAIN OR SHINE

RV SITES - \$25 per night. Thursday drop off - no hookup/no charge.

SCRATCH/ADD CLASSES - Scratches and add/ons of classes must be accomplished 2 classes prior to the class that is scratched or added enters the arena. This must be done by completing a scratch/add slip at the show office. **You will be charged** for classes scratched without following this procedure.

STALLS - Stalls may be reserved by pre-entry **ONLY**. Sat night stalls must move in AFTER 1pm on Saturday. No more than two stalls per entry. **Requests for stall location will be honored first come/first served. To be stalled together, please help us by pre-entering together.**

SHAVINGS - GIHP requires a minimum of 2 bags of shavings per stall. Bring your own shavings or order and pay by credit card through **Queen Shavings at 770-860-9111 or 678-416-1424** or at the show grounds at Queen Shavings Building.

STALLIONS - Youth may not handle stallions at NCSC shows - no exceptions.
