

Common Questions From OCAP Exhibitors

What are the requirements for participating in the OCAP program?

The horse, pony, or miniature must be permanently registered with PtHA and must be enrolled in the OCAP program. The owner must be a current PtHA member and the exhibitor(s) must also be members.

Once I am enrolled, how do I find PtHA approved OCAP shows?

PtHA approved OCAP shows will be listed in:

- *Pinto Horse* magazine
- www.pinto.org

If a show has approval, do all the classes the show offers have approval also?

Not all classes a show offers are approved for OCAP points. Each show receives an approval letter. If a show does not have this approval letter, it either was not approved or falls under the category discussed in the next question.

I noticed that some shows that are recognized by other associations do not appear on any of the approval lists. Can I still get points for those shows?

Shows approved by associations listed in the PtHA Rule Book do not have to apply for show approval. They receive automatic show approval and therefore will not have an approval letter or show code. You will still need to examine the class list for appropriate OCAP classes.

How are the points calculated?

We use the OCOM point scale found in the current PtHA Rule Book.

Are the points recorded on my horse's show record?

Yes, all points earned and accepted are recorded on your horse's permanent show record. Points earned are then used toward OCAP awards such as the Open Certificate of Merit, and the OCAP Year End Awards program.
